

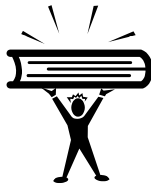
Do You Have Aphasia? (ah-fay-zhuh)

After a brain injury, you might have problems speaking. One type of problem is called Aphasia.

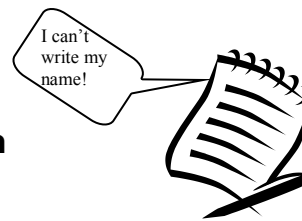
With Aphasia, you might have difficulty **finding your words**.
